Every year from Mid-June through October more than 1.5 million the wildebeest and more than 200,000 zebras and Gazelles migrate from the Great Plains of the Serengeti and into the rolling savannahs of Masai Mara in Kenya. They are relentlessly pursued by the Africa great predators, lions, leopards, cheetahs and hyenas; this is the best time to be in Kenya and by far the best time to see the river crossings. Everyone should have the opportunity once in their lifetime to stand on the great savannah of Masai Mara to witness one of the last wildlife spectacles on planet earth. This natural phenomenon draws the attention of predators and it is quite simply a wildlife enthusiasts and photographer's paradise. Mix this safari with luxury accommodations of authentic Africa of days gone by, and you will not only have hundreds of great images but also ***an experience of a lifetime.***

DAY 2: JUNE 9TH
CITY TOUR AND OTHER ATTRACTIONS

Whether you are hand-feeding gentle Rothschild giraffes, interacting with orphaned elephants and rhinos or glimpsing into the former home of the author of "Out of Africa" Karen Blixen, your day is bursting with an overview of Kenya's diverse conservation efforts and a taste of its colonial history. Your safari guide introduces you to the staff and caregivers at Giraffe Centre, headquarters of the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife (AFEW), and the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, acclaimed for its rehabilitation of orphaned rhinos and elephants for their return to the wild.

DAY 3: JUNE 10TH

SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

This morning follow in the soft tracks of the elephants as you move north to the arid Samburu Reserve. In the afternoon meet your guide for a game viewing drive along the life-giving river. Watch out for crocodiles sharing the banks with elephants, lions, buffalo and even the leopard comes down to drink. Encounter the red-robed Samburu people, still practicing their ancient ways.

DAY 4: JUNE 11TH

SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

While exploring with your guide on morning and afternoon game viewing drives, continue to build your gallery of photos as you spot the rare wildlife only found north of the equator, the special 5- Reticulated giraffe, Grevy's zebra, Beisa Oryx, the Gerenuk and Somali ostrich.

On this day, you will also have a chance to visit a Samburu village and mingle with the tribe as you learn more about their fascinating culture and traditions. Feel free to join the young Warriors jumping and the women dancing as they celebrate your visit. The Samburu people are the cousins of the Maasai tribe and they share the same customs and traditions.

DAY 5: JUNE 12TH

OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY

Rise early and drive to the private Ol Pejeta Conservancy, the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. Begin your wildlife viewing right from your luxurious tented camp - its waterhole attracts a wide variety of game day and night. This afternoon, hop aboard an open-topped safari vehicle with your knowledgeable Kosen safari guide to spot both the endangered black and northern white rhino and their fellow brethren of the Big Five. The density of wildlife here is greater than any of Kenya's national parks. While further tracking the rhinos, your guide will point out other rare species including Grevy's zebra and the Jackson's hartebeest. Visit the Chimpanzee Sanctuary, the only sanctuary for chimps in Eastern Africa, and learn about its mission to provide lifelong refuge to orphaned and abused chimpanzees from central and Western Africa. In the evening gather for sundowners and take in the stunning views of Mount Kenya.

DAYS 6 & 7: JUNE 13TH /14TH

LAKE ELEMENTAITA

Uniquely situated on the shoreline of sapphire-blue Lake Elementaita where hundreds of thousands of birds congregate, is the small and exclusive Lake Elementaita Serena Camp. This area of breathtaking beauty, also home to many rare species of animals, is less than two hours' drive from Nairobi. Evocatively styled to echo the area's rich history, the camp blends aristocratic elegance with modern luxury and will offer cuisine and service of fittingly high standards. The Conservancy protects over 450 bird species and 15,000 wild animals. Rothschild giraffes have found a safe haven for breeding here, while a diverse variety of terrain shelters many species - from herds of giant elands to tiny dik-diks and cliff-dwelling klipspringers.

Nature walk and horseback riding safari are available; you will see zebra, antelopes and gazelle among other wildlife found around the lake.

DAY 8: JUNE 15TH

MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Today you will awake to the exotic birdcalls in a magical new world with the aroma of Kenyan coffee brewing. We will meet at breakfast for a safari briefing driving to Masai Mara National Reserve. We will arrive at camp with enough time to settle in before lunch with a little time to relax before we head out on our first game drive.

Your luxury camp is positioned to blend unobtrusively into the surrounding vegetation and has an authentic safari feel of days gone by. There is no better way to experience Africa than by spending a few nights under canvas and there is no better way to photograph than by camping in the heart of the migration! Sitting close to the campfire at night, you will enjoy the stary African night and once safely escorted to your tent by your Masai Warrior, you will be lulled asleep to the sound of grazing Hippo and roaring lion.

DAYS 9 &10: JUNE 16TH /17TH

MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

After an early morning cup of fresh coffee or tea you will head out for the magical plains. Breakfast will be packed into a basket and carried with you, ready to be served anytime during the morning, whilst enjoying your morning game viewing safari. Your driver and guide will be constantly reading the herd and other wildlife movements and sharing with you the possibilities of sightings ahead. Where safe, comfortable and reasonable, a long stop will be necessary to wait for the buildup required for a river crossing to happen. Whilst you wait there will be ample time to observe other wildlife going about their daily routines. Ample photographic opportunities abound all around you and our seasoned driver/guides will orchestrate the best approach possible to ensure that you are placed as safely to the sighting as possible, whilst always taking light, wind and shadows into consideration and aiming to remain a passive by stander rather than an intruder on any sighting.

Dinner at the camp can be outside under a canopy of Southern Hemisphere stars with pre-dinner cocktails and nibbles around the campfire to chat and discuss the days' sightings.

DAY 11: JUNE 18TH

MASAI MARA /NAIROBI/ OUTBOUND

You spend this last morning in the Mara admiring the unspoiled Africa as you prepare to return to the Nairobi. We bid farewell to the camp staff and the friends we met here in Masai Mara.

VISIT A MAASAI VILLAGE AND NKOILALE PRIMARY

On your way, out of the reserve you will have the opportunity to visit several homes that have benefited from Kosen safaris Lights 4 village solar lights project which is part of our social responsibility. Learn how the lights have help transform the lives of the village and how they have made a huge and positive impact in the lives of the school kids. You will also have an opportunity to visit Nkoilale primary school where we are sponsoring 27 girls and 3 boys to get an education. All these girls were rescued from an early marriage at a tender age as young as 12 years old. They will be happy to share with you their personal stories and how going to school has changed their lives.

We head back to Nairobi arriving in the afternoon. Spend the remainder of the afternoon at leisure; a dayroom is provided for your convenience. Later this evening you are transferred to the Airport for your flight home.
